The SAT is an aptitude test. Testing reasoning & verbal abilities

BHS Code:110794

Perfect score: 1600

National Average: 1060

*Each section is worth 200-800 points, which are added together for a combined score.

*There is no penalty for wrong answers, therefore **do not** leave anything blank.

ACT

The ACT is an achievement test. Measuring what a student learned

BHS Code: 110794

Perfect score: 36

National Average: 21

*Each subject is worth 1-36 points, which are averaged together for a composite score.

*There is not a penalty for wrong answers, therefore **do not** leave anything blank.

*5 subjects: English, Math, Reading, Science, Writing. (Essay optional)

COMPASS or Accuplacer Exam:

Computer-Adaptive College Placement Test used for acceptance at 2 year or technical colleges (SAT & ACT can be used as well).

*This exam scheduled through the specific 2 year/tech college you are applying to

* Evaluates skill levels in Reading, Writing, & Math

*Helps place students in appropriate courses (college or remedial level)

ASVAB Score Range

The highest score on the ASVAB is a 99 and the lowest score is a one. Scores are based on the mean of all examinees. The ASVAB measures your knowledge and ability in ten different areas. It is not an IQ test, but the ASAVB does help the various branches of the military assess which jobs you are best suited to perform

BRANCH REQUIREMENTS

Each branch of the service has a minimum score set for entry. The higher your score the better chance you have of not only enlisting in your chosen branch but also gaining an opportunity to gain the position you want.

- Coast Guard – 40
- Marine Corps – 32
- Navy -35
